

The ice rinks will open as soon as conditions allow. Traditionally in mid-December. We strive to maintain the ice to allow for as long of a skating season as possible and will notify residents by email and through the website [www.lakesummerside.ca](http://www.lakesummerside.ca) once the ice is open for the 2024/2025 Season.

### ONCE THE ICE HAS BEGUN TO APPEAR

- Stay off the ice until the ice thickness is safe to allow traffic.
- Do not throw rocks onto the ice as this impairs the ice skating quality
- Stay off the ice until maintenance staff has had the chance to do their work and the SSRA has announced it is safe for traffic. As you might see staff on the ice surfaces, it does not mean it is safe for residents and guests. The staff performs comprehensive ice thickness testing on the throughout the lake. (Lake ice thickness varies on depth of the water, shoreline thickness will be thicker than ice out further) Thin ice signs will be in place during the process

The ice is not available for booking or rental at any time and is only closed during severe weather or dangerous ice conditions.

- No gas powered equipment of any kind is permitted on the ice. This means no snow blowers, ice augers, water pumps, quads etc.
- Alcohol is not permitted on Summerside Residents Association property.
- Ice fishing holes are not permitted within five meters of any prepared skating surface.
- Ice fishing huts are not permitted to remain on the ice after park hours.
- After hours park usage is not permitted.
