

SSRA Architectural Change Request

Instructions & Requirements

Member & City Approvals Required (Incomplete applications will not be reviewed)

Before starting any exterior project, you may need approval from:

- 1. **Summerside Residents Association (SSRA)** ensures your project meets community architectural guidelines and neighbourhood standards.
- 2. **City of Edmonton** ensures compliance with municipal bylaws, zoning, and building codes.

Approval Process

- Step 1. Complete the SSRA Architectural Change Request Form (Page 2).
- Step 2. Gather required documents:
 - Working drawings (3/16" or 1/8" scale)
 - Two plot plans at 1:300 scale
 - Material/colour samples (if requested)
 - Any applicable forms (Lot Inspection Report, Housing Start Information, Acknowledgement of Structured Wiring, Residents Association Summary).
- Step 3. Submit your complete package to SSRA (allow 5 business days for review).
- Step 4. If required, apply for City of Edmonton permits after SSRA approval.
- Step 5. Begin work only after written approval from both SSRA and the City.

City of Edmonton – Permit Triggers

Development and/or Building Permit may be required if:

- Structure is over 10 m² (107 sq. ft.)
- It is attached to your home
- It is has walls or an enclosed roof
- It is located within **setback distances** from property lines
- It changes the lot grading or drainage

Workflow: Member Completes Form \rightarrow SSRA Approval \rightarrow City Permit (if required) \rightarrow Construction Begins
