## WHY WE CAN'T ACCEPT A TRANSFER OF LAND DOCUMENT ALONE

We understand that this process can sometimes feel frustrating, so we want to explain why we cannot accept a "Transfer of Land" document on its own as proof of ownership for membership in the Summerside Residents Association.

## The reason is simple:

## In Alberta, the Transfer of Land form does not prove that you own the property.

It is just a step in the paperwork used to *request* that the government update the land registry. Until that request is processed and your name appears on the official **Land Title Certificate**, the change in ownership is **not legally complete**.

Our association is required to follow the bylaws, which state that **membership is connected to being a** "**registered owner**" of a property in Summerside (Bylaw Article 4). The only way to confirm that status is through a government-issued Land Title or a signed Purchase Agreement that shows the sale is in progress.

## To confirm your membership, we can accept either:

- 1. A copy of your Land Title Certificate, OR
- 2. A signed Land Purchase Agreement, if your title is still being registered.

We apply this standard to treat all residents equally and fairly.
